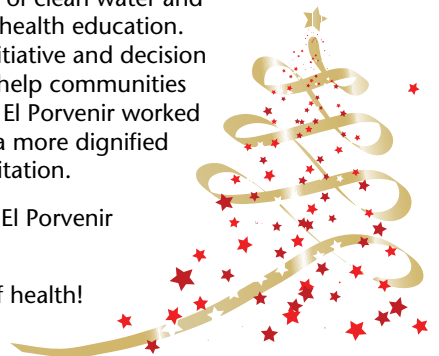


Dear Friends of EP,

**ROPE PUMP FOR A WELL \$190**

*Designed in Nicaragua, made with all local, inexpensive parts. Community members are trained to install and make repairs*



**NEW WELL \$2400**

*Hand-dug by community members, lined to prevent contamination, the well is sealed, the rope pump is covered and concrete skirt is connected to drainage directed away from the area. The water is tested regularly for cleanliness.*

**FAMILY DOUBLE PIT LATRINE \$450**

*For every \$1 invested in sanitation, \$7 is returned through improved worker productivity and children attaining better education when they don't miss school due to illness*



**COMPLETE VILLAGE LAVANDERO \$2750**

*A washing and bathing facility, where women can do laundry in clean water without standing ankle-deep in contaminated mud, and villagers bathe in privacy*



**COLORING BOOKS & CRAYONS FOR SCHOOL \$95**

*Hygiene education illustrates the connection between good health and good hygiene. Coloring books provide a fun reinforcement to the lessons.*



#### IMPROVED COOKING STOVE \$130

*Using 60% less firewood than traditional cook stoves, this stove has two burners and a chimney that takes away the smoke. Less firewood means fewer trees cut down, and the chimney improves indoor air quality and health.*

#### PLASTIC BAGS & SEEDS FOR A VILLAGE SEEDLING NURSERY \$60

*The first step in our reforestation program is creating a village tree nursery; the seedlings will later be strategically replanted throughout the village micro-watershed. Families involved in this program are rewarded with fruit trees that improve family nutrition as well as contribute to reforestation efforts.*
